- 3-way cooperation Oman Broadband Company (OBC), Oman Electricity Transmission
 Company (OETC) and the Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (TRA) to launch pilot
 project to provide high speed internet services using the fibre-optic cable infrastructure of
 electricity companies. Read More
- Qatar has reached another milestone with more than 200,000 customers from Ooredoo
 Qatar connected to its faster fibre network where Ooredoo has managed to accelerate the
 pace of people being connected to Fibre during 2014 with around 9,000 homes a month are
 now being linked to Ooredoo Fibre. Read More.
- Bahrain Telecommunications Company (Batelco) has expanded its fibre-optic network to the city of Riffa, with down/uplink speeds of up to 150Mbps/15Mbps. Existing broadband customers will be automatically migrated onto the new fibre network. Read More

- Irish operator Eircom has invested EUR1 billion (USD1.16 billion) on the deployment of fibre broadband since 2012 and has EUR500 million left to spend by mid-2016 which mostly is intended for the installation of fibre infrastructure to rural premises, pending government approval and financial support. - Zimbabwe Online (ZOL), has unveiled the country's lowest priced fibre-optic broadband service. Read More.
- Covage France will deploy and operate a fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) network in Seine-et-Marne, a department situated in the region of Ile-de-France with future plan to pass 319,000 homes. Read More.
