MENA FIBRE NEWS

- **FTTH Council MENA** conducted the FTTH Training Level 2 from 24 to 27 March 2015 in Etisalat Academy Dubai with 12 participants from around the region. The Council is committed to continue its workshops and training in the MENA Region to maximize the knowledge and education in Fiber Optics.
- Another initiative by **FTTH Council MENA** to promote the national broadband deployment through its speaking participation in the workshop organized by ITU in Amman on 23 & 24 March 2015. FTTH Council MENA and the ITU cooperation will help promoting the fiber infrastructure deployment in the region for a sustainable broadband development.
- Fiber Optics in Comex 2015 with the support of FTTH Council MENA. [Read More.](#)
- Omantel has announced earlier a project to introduce Fiber to the Home (FTTH) technology in Oman. The project has been implemented in many phases starting with main cities in different governorate. The company continues its endeavors to extend FTTH to the newly planned areas as alternative for the copper cables that were used in the past. [Read More.](#)
- Telecom Egypt plans to spend more than \$400 million this year mainly on building a fibre network in the country. [Read More.](#)

WORLD FIBRE & RESEARCH NEWS

- Telco in Cayman Islands has concluded the rollout of its nationwide fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) network on schedule, following a USD30 million investment programme providing to all citizens access to speeds of 100Mbps. [Read More.](#)
- Kenya Liquid Telecom plans to use USD150 million loan to roll out fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) services in Kenya with already pilot projects started in few cities of the country [Read More.](#)
- Zimbabwean operator TelOne will be extending fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) high speed internet networks to new areas covering some 9,500 households in the country. [Read More.](#)
- The Indian government has rolled out fibre-optic links to 5,000 villages as part of its National Optical Fibre Network Project (NOFN) which aims to connect all 250,000 small towns with speeds of at least 100Mbps. [Read More.](#)
- The annual Broadband survey of Sweden's Post & Telestyrelsen (PTS, or Post and Telecom Agency) has been released for 2014, showing that 61% of all households and businesses in Sweden had access to fixed broadband speeds of at least 100Mbps at the end of October 2014 with fibre (FTTH/FTTB) broadband connections increased by five percentage points to 54%. - Ireland's Eircom will launch fibre-to-the-home (FTTH)-enabled speeds of 150Mbps, 300Mbps and 1Gbps in the first 16 - of a planned 66 - locations by the end of August with 1Gbps FTTH service will launch on a wholesale and retail basis in August. [Read More.](#)
- Costa Rica State-owned utility firm Instituto Costarricense de Electricidad (ICE), will begin selling fibre-based broadband to around 100,000 homes and businesses in September 2015 with new services to be offered over the Next Generation Access Network providing speeds

of 30Mbps-100Mbps to 20,000 premises. [Read More.](#)
