#### WORLD FIBRE & RESEARCH NEWS

Maldives' incumbent telecoms operator, has announced the launch of its new 'Fibre Broadband' service, which provides maximum download speeds of up to 100Mbps. Coverage of the fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) network is currently available in the capital. Read More.

- Ireland Fixed broadband provider Eircom has rolled out 100Mbps fibre speeds to 50,000 households which will extend its fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) coverage to rural villages by mid-2016. Read More.
- US operator AT&T has continued its deployment of 'GigaPower' 1Gbps fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) services which will soon be available in parts of the Chicago area. AT&T's Chicago Gigapower rollout is initially focusing on improving broadband access speeds at housing developments. Read More.
- France Orange plans to invest 3 billion euros in France to expand its fiber reach to 4 million connectable households in April 2015, 12 million in 2018, and 20 million in 2022. Read More.
- Maltese telco GO has revealed that it plans to invest more than EUR50 million (USD54 million) over the next five years to deploy FTTH technology nationwide with commercial services due to be launched in the next few weeks. Read More.
