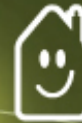

- French telecoms Orange has launched its fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) network in Saint-Malo, which is located in Brittany, the seventh largest administrative region of France with 10,524 homes. [Read More](#).
- US operator AT&T is offering a new fiber footprint that can now deliver 1 Gbps services to multi-tenant office buildings in more than 180 cities in the United States which will support symmetrical 300 Mbps with the ability to scale to 1 Gbps. [Read More](#)
- Irish telecoms provider Eircom has revealed that it is deploying fibre broadband at a rate of

10,000 premises per week in its bid to win the government's upcoming National Broadband Plan (NBP) tender. [Read More](#)

- Indonesia (Telkom) service IndiHome branded fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) service is now available in 60 towns and cities across the country and continuing to strengthen the triple-play IndiHome service with the carrier's commitment to deliver fibre country-wide. [Read More.](#)
- Uruguay's national telecoms operator Administracion Nacional de Telecomunicaciones (Antel) has reached 550,000 households connected to the fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) network up from 500,000 in December 2014 with plans to invest USD1.112 billion in its operations by 2017, around USD727 million for the rollout and expansion of its FTTH infrastructure.
