The Technology & Training Committee of the FTTH Council MENA published a new white paper on FTTH Architectures and Evolution of PON and Point-to-Point. Download the paper here.

- The Fibre-to-the-Home (FTTH) Council MENA has announced that it will hold the seventh FTTH Council MENA Conference in Muscat from 9th-11th November. Read more.
- Oman's Information Technology Authority (ITA) and the government-owned Oman Broadband Company (OBC) have signed a deal to develop a high speed fibre optic backbone for the Oman Government Network (OGN). Read more.
- Ooredoo Oman has announced the completion of its national fibre-optic backbone, which spans almost 5,500km, to provide high speed reliable connectivity to residential and businesses customers across the Sultanate. Read more.

WORLD FIBRE & RESEARCH NEWS

- Polish fixed and mobile operator Orange Polska has revealed that it invested PLN740 million (USD196 million) in the first six months of 2015 expanding its fibre-to-the-home (FTTH) and Long Term Evolution (LTE) networks. Read more.
- MNC Kabel Mediacom (MKM), a unit of Media Nusantara Citra (MNC Media), is looking to
 invest in its ongoing service expansion in the country with a view to signing up 50,000 fibre
 broadband users by end-2015. Read more.
- During the annual Southern Africa Telecommunication Networks and Applications
 Conference (SATNAC), Maseko detailed that Telkom has already connected 38 000 homes
 to its own FTTH connections, and will have connected 400 000 by the end of next year.
 Read more.
- The Obama administration unveiled a plan to invest \$160 million in smart cities research and partner with dozens of technology firms to deploy smart cities solutions. Read more.
- The ITU's latest broadband report made for disappointing reading, as the UN telco body revealed it has missed its 2015 broadband targets and admitted those same targets are unlikely to be met by 2020. <u>Read more</u>.
- US Ignite is excited to announce that it has been awarded a \$6 million dollar grant from the National Science Foundation to build a living lab of testbeds for smart gigabit applications in 15 communities throughout the country. Read more.
- Time Warner Cable Business Class announced its deal with Harmony Public Schools (HPS) to supply fiber Internet providing 1 Gbps speeds, and managed security services to 46 campuses along with the HPS Central Office in Texas. Read more.
